COVID-19 UPDATE

What a difference just two weeks makes.

The REIQ two-day Summit and Awards for Excellence Gala event seem like a lifetime ago, and in hindsight was to be our industry's last chance for a while to network and learn. Our team was thrilled to take home the trophy for Medium Agency of the Year Award and for one night, we celebrated.

Little did we know that winning this award would take on a whole new meaning as COVID-19 suddenly became the nation's priority. We knew that many in the industry would be looking to us for guidance, so we took the lead and made decisions that have proven to be the right course of action.

My priority was the safety of our staff. If one team member became sick and spread it to the others, our service would cease. We postponed all visits to tenanted properties until we can find other solutions (which we are working on).

We quickly set up our team to work from home, leaving just a small group of admin staff at our offices to receive visitors and aid the property management team to work remotely. Adopting technology solutions is a large part of our company's business plan, so the move to an offsite workforce has been surprisingly smooth. We have been able to adapt our processes and continue to provide the standard of service and care that our owner and tenant clients have come to expect.

The biggest topic of conversation surrounds rent payments. The federal government's announcement of a moratorium on evictions for non-payment of rent has sent waves of panic throughout the industry. **But until the state government formulates their policy, it is impossible to speculate how this will work in practical terms. Once we have details, I will send out an email communication.**

On Friday 3rd April, the REIQ is holding a webinar for property managers throughout Queensland to discuss COVID-19 and how to work with the new guidelines to best serve our clients. I have been asked to participate as a panellist to explain what our agency is doing to continue to operate in this 'new normal'. I hope this gives our clients reassurance that we are leading the way through these uncertain times for property investors.
